The emotions, the social being, the mind, and the skills needed for a career direction are all focuses of humanistic education. Much of a humanist teacher's effort would be put into developing a child's self-esteem. It would be important for children to feel good about themselves (high self-esteem), and to feel that they can set and achieve appropriate goals (high self-efficacy). Procedures are suggested.
